### Slaughter Pig Marketing Summary

This week
The week was marred by a couple of large factory breakdowns which had the affect of rolling some pigs into this trading week. However, a sign of a good demand for the meat saw one of the affected companies instigate a Saturday kill to try and catch up. Supply continued to be shy of demand with most majors still short of their required numbers. Factory price contributions stood on but contract prices increased due to improvement in other market fundamentals. The fresh meat market was a touch quieter with odd comment here and there saying that loins were more difficult to move. Prices stood on however, with supplies still particularly tight. Cull sows saw a reverse of 1p due to currency fluctuations. In Europe, the Spanish market continued the trend of recent weeks adding another 1.5 eurocents, while the rest of the quoted countries stood on. Quotes in sterling were slightly compromised by a weaker Euro , which ended the week down 0.19p at 87.45p.

### Weaner Marketing Summary

w/c 11/06/17
Supplies of both 7kgs weaners and 30kgs stores improved again, driven mainly by offerings from breeder feeder operations wanting to make a bit of space. Demand remained strong with fatteners keen to fill up empty accommodation. The prices announced by the AHDB saw the weighted average for a 30kg pig fall by 71p to £59.54 and the weighted average for a 7kg rise by 57p to £43.86.
