Slaughter Pig Marketing Summary

This week
While the weather returned to a more seasonal trend, the recent hot weather spell has still adversely affected pig performance. Supply was very tight with many producers commenting on stifled growth rates. Most of the majors were shy of their contract numbers. Contract prices improved again with increases in contributions ranging from a penny to five pence. Coupled to this was the fact that a number of monthly and quarterly priced contracts were up for renewal and they all increased handsomely. These increases will have a positive affect on the SPP in the coming weeks. The fresh meat market remained buoyant, and a better supply saw prices improve. The black spot of the day was reserved for cull sows where poorer trade on the continent saw prices fall 4p. In Europe, the Spanish market continued to push ahead price wise on the back of good domestic and export demand. The rest of Europe stood on, although German sows fell dramatically. The Euro ended the week slightly stronger, up 0.13p at 87.93p.

Weaner Marketing Summary

w/c 25/06/17
There was a slightly better supply of both 7kgs weaners and 30kgs stores this week and good demand ensured that prices were a strong stand on. The prices announced by the AHDB saw the weighted average for a 30kg pig fall by 61p to £60.25 and the weighted average for a 7kg rise by 41p to £44.37.
