Slaughter Pig Marketing Summary

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| Another week of processor issues – breakdowns, staffing levels, poor demand, conspired to reduce pig allocations offered. The upshot was a further increase in the backlog. Conditions on farm, both physically, and increasingly mentally are deteriorating. The resilience of producers and farm staff is being tested to the extreme, and there are little signs of imminent improvement. The SPP fell to 139p, the lowest level since April 2019, and the SPP weight was another record at 95.42 kgs. Demand was dismal for all classes of stock, and cheap import pressure was a feature of many fresh meat conversations. The sow market remained under pressure with exporters experiencing a torrid trade. European markets saw major downturns in Holland (-7.5c) and Germany (-3c). The Euro was little changed, up 0.12p at 83.63p. |

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| The weaner market continues to suffer from the slaughter backlog, with unit turnaround badly compromised. The upshot is that weaners are unable to move and must be retained until we concoct a new plan. There was insufficient data for the AHDB to calculate any weaner or store pig prices. |
