Slaughter Pig Marketing Summary

(Ref Weekly Tribune)

This week
Demand faltered with “summer holiday mode” affecting both retail footfall and staffing at processors. This made the day particularly difficult placing both rolled stock and pigs compromised by the recent hot weather spell. Contract price contributions stood on, but other market fundamentals improved thereby giving a positive direction to prices. The fresh meat market remained subdued, with poor high street sales, and plentiful cheap imports affecting demand. Cull sow demand was stable, but prices eased a penny on adverse currency. In Europe, Ireland and Denmark showed good increases, but prices in sterling were compromised by a weaker Euro that ended the week down 1.15p at 83.99p – a 3 month low.
