## Slaughter Pig Marketing Summary

Some good movements in Europe, topped by The Netherlands moving up 11.29p/kg but three other countries moving over 8p/kg! These are huge moves happening and these significant moves have now happened for three consecutive weeks. GB Cull sow price moved nearly 10p/kg for the second consecutive week, a reflection of a tight pork market in Europe. It was therefore disappointing to see one processor feeling they couldn't or did not need to increase their contribution price. Could this combination make some producers question their future? Kantar data shows Veganuary was a flop, both in terms of volume and value. Volumes of sales dropped 12.9%! Although M&S are going to close some stores they intend to open in excess of 100 more food halls and we all know pork does very well in the snacking sector and M&S are good supporters of British. Within this fast food dining sector that we have do we need to find more easy pork meal solutions?
