We mentioned a year ago to the week that Chris Fox had announced his intention to retire by May 2023, Chris has now 'left the building', officially retiring last Friday (5<sup>th</sup> May). I am sure you will all join us in wishing Chris a happy and healthy retirement. Chris has served the business for 30 years. He has been a stalwart through his continuous employment, originally with the Fishers Business, ALM, prior to it being acquired by TVC back in 2009. In more pig related industry news, the market is similar to unchanged, as it has been over the first few months of 2023. Still not enough pigs about, prices are improving weekly (breaking records weekly), and processor pressures intensifies, on the one hand requiring more volume but on the other reluctant to pay more because of retailor resistance. European prices largely stood on, barring France which came off 0.072 euros/kg, which with the down turn in currency, amounts to 8.09p/kg (sterling). Sows also stood on, again with very few sows now being sold, with people potentially ordering more gilts, to fill gaps in their systems created over the previous 18months. However as we all know this increase will not come quick enough and we are still seeing a downward trend in slaughter numbers coming through until as far as the end of June!
