We have seen another week where pig supply is incredibly short, if not the shortest we have seen it, whilst we anticipated that the summer infertility and the impact of the winter weather on weaners would catch us up. The forecasts show that the next week or 2 will be equally as short before we start the climb towards recovery.
The impact of the changes to prepare for the closure of Pilgrims Ashton, is also being felt, with some pigs moving already to their alternative site for slaughter. This migration over a few weeks will greatly assist in a smooth transition.
SPP increased again but with a considerably smaller sample than previous weeks circa 4000 pigs down on the prior week!
On a slightly more positive note, many will have noticed the raw material price eroding, however still not to levels seen pre the conflict in Ukraine. Many producers are still feeding todays pigs on expensive feed covered over the previous year which will still influence their COP at least until harvest time.
