One of the major processors bought another large independent pig business increasing its self sufficiency causing a few heads to turn. Quote of the week in The Times, "Prioritise farm workers or face food price rises, says Sainsburys boss!" Particularly pertinent as more farms seem to be looking for staff. NPA highlight their deep concern about reports that Government is about to delay the introduction of checks on food imports from the EU again.
