Slaughter Pig Marketing Summary

This week

Another tough week with little optimism to report. Staffing levels remained the major issue and was blamed for the continued inadequate allocations from many processors. Pigs continued to back up, with worrying reports of farms at capacity. The backlog was highlighted by the latest SPP report which showed the lowest sample size of the year at 70,400 head and the average sample weight increased by 1.2kgs to 88.4 kgs – a 6 month high. Contract prices continued to fall with weekly contributions down 1p to 2p. The fresh meat market was steadier with reports of cheap imports taking market share. The cull sow market struggled as exporters were met with a limited market. This meant another curtailed kill and prices fell a further 3p. European markets saw large falls with Belgium back 9 eurocents and Germany falling another 5 eurocents. Price quotes in sterling were enhanced slightly by a stronger Euro that ended the week up 0.14p at 85.84p.

Weaner Marketing Summary

The backlog in slaughtering is having a major detrimental effect on the weaner market with many moves now delayed or cancelled due to yards and buildings not being cleared. There were no quoted prices issued by the AHDB.
